

TWIN RIVER CASINOS ANNOUNCE RELAXED COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

PROVIDENCE, RHODE ISLAND, MAY 21, 2021: Twin River Casino Hotel in Lincoln and the Tiverton Casino Hotel announced today that in accordance with state and CDC guidelines, COVID-19 restrictions have been relaxed.

Specifically:

Masks are required for non-fully vaccinated guests and employee only (based on the honor system);

Plexiglass will be removed from the gaming floors with the exception of the barrier separating the dealer from the guests and designated areas; a limited number of tables will have four positions for guests who prefer more social distancing;

Bars and restaurants are open at 100 percent capacity;

Wicked Good Sportsbook Bar open for beverage service and limited seating;

Temperature and ID scanning are no longer required;

All slot machines will be enabled (4,067 in Lincoln and 1,000 in Tiverton) with plexiglass dividers being removed; Twin River's 2nd floor will be open 24/7/365;

Three feet of social distancing is no longer required and is the responsibility of the guest to maintain comfortable distancing;

The facility will remain non-smoking;

Cleaning protocols for chips, cards and high contact areas will remain in place;

Valet & shuttle service are not yet being offered. The following amenities are under review and will remain offline until further notice: both hotels, live entertainment, Event Center, Fred & Steve's Steakhouse, Shipyard Pub, Poker Room & VIP Lounge.
